Program Description

The City of El Cerrito Arts and Culture Commission (ACC) juries the El Cerrito City Hall Gallery Space, a north-facing wall located on the second-floor loft hallway of City Hall. The exhibit space, located at 10890 San Pablo Avenue, measures 42.75 feet (513") in length and 7.33 feet (88") in height, with a rail-wire hanging system. Artwork must be hung on open wall space in the designated gallery space area using the provided hanging system. Wall-mounted artwork must have appropriate hanging hardware.

Artists interested in showing their work in the City Hall Gallery Space must submit a proposal and 6-15 samples of their works of art (photographs, paintings, digital renderings) to be presented to the ACC for review and consideration. Work samples should represent a theme selected by the artist and be reflected in the proposal. From time to time, the ACC may announce themes for upcoming shows, so artists may consider those before submitting. Application Guidelines

- Application materials must be clear and able to read on a computer.
- Artist's Statement -- discussing theme of proposed gallery exhibition and how artist's interests and background relates to this theme (at least 300 words). Include the proposed theme, and number of artworks. Applicants should indicate if they will have enough work for a solo exhibition. (If there is not enough work for a solo exhibition, applicants should indicate if they are willing to participate in a joint show with another artist or in a group show.)
- Artist resume, curriculum vitae, or background material.
- Photographs of or examples of works of art (6-15). Images should be JPG or PDF files. Include an image list of the sample works that includes title, medium, and size, for each piece.

Theme

Artwork that highlights the breadth of artists and works being created in and near El Cerrito, California.

Eligibility

1. This program is open to individual artists, teams of artists, or community groups with a designated lead artist.
2. Applicants must reside in either Contra Costa or Alameda County (East San Francisco Bay Area). Proof of residency may be requested. Preference is given to artists who are residents of the City of El Cerrito.
3. Preference will be given to youth artists and community groups that coordinate a show around a group of students.
4. Preference will be given to artwork that was created entirely through traditional human authorship as opposed to artwork that was created primarily through the use of artificial intelligence (AI) or generative AI tools.
5. Selected artists will be required to sign a liability waiver/consent form in order to participate in the program.

Program & Artwork Requirements

- The artwork must be suitable for viewing by all ages in a public space. Generally, this rule means that the art may not contain advertising, religious art, violence, sexual content, or political partisanship. Designs that do not comply with these standards will not be approved by the City and/or eligible for the program.
- All entries must be the original design and artwork of the applicant(s); artwork must not be plagiarized, stolen, or copied.
- Artwork must be an original design and the artwork of the applicant.
- Artwork must not defame or invade the rights of any person, living or dead.
- Artworks that use copyrighted or trademarked images are not eligible unless legal permission has been granted.
- The artist(s) name and a photo of the artwork may be featured on the City of El Cerrito website and other promotional materials.

Evaluation Criteria (not in order of importance)

- Residency
- Applicant examples of previous work
- Creativity and originality
- Adherence to the project theme (if applicable), as described above
- The relationship of the proposed artwork to the social and/or cultural identity of the El Cerrito community

Showing in the City Hall Gallery Space

Following ACC approval, the Gallery exhibit will be scheduled with the artist(s). Exhibits are scheduled for 8-10 weeks, and the artist will comply with the following:

- Artist(s) must sign Artist's Agreement and provide complete inventory list on day the artwork is installed in the Gallery Space. The ACC recommends that artists arrange for private insurance coverage for their exhibit.
- Artist(s) must install artwork on the designated date under supervision of the ACC and/or City staff, who will provide access to the Gallery Space, and must remove artwork at the end of the exhibit period on the designated date. Available hours for installation and removal are 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on regular business days (closed every other Friday), or by special arrangement with the ACC Staff Liaison.
- Artwork must be hung on open wall space in the designated gallery space area using the provided hanging system. Wall-mounted artwork must have appropriate hanging hardware. Adhesives or tape are not used on gallery walls. Drilling directly into the wall is prohibited. The artist is responsible for installation of artwork, removal, and any repair as stated in the Artist's Agreement. Exhibits involving multiple artists will be curated by the ACC.
- The artist(s) is encouraged to have a reception at City Hall during the exhibit period. Receptions must be scheduled in advance with the ACC Staff Liaison to determine an available date and time. The artist is responsible for the reception, set-up, supplies, refreshments, and clean-up following the reception. Receptions are held outside of regular business hours at City Hall.
- The City will publish the scheduled exhibition list in various City publications and on the City's website. Additional advertising and the sale of the artwork is handled entirely by the artist(s).

(6:00 p.m.) CONVENE REGULAR MEETING Chair Renée LeVesque called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. **COMMISSIONERS' REPORTS, COUNCIL LIAISON AND STAFF LIAISON REPORTS**
Staff Liaison Provost announced that the public art on the private development at the Little Lamb Bilingual Preschool located at 729 Kearney St. has been completed and noted that the El Cerrito City Council approved of the fiscal year 2026-27 and 2027-28 Biennial Budget at the City Council Meeting on June 16, 2026. Notably, the budget as adopted will maintain General Fund reserves above \$20 million over the next 5 years, greater than 29% of expenditures.

4. **MINI GRANT APPLICATION FOR SUNJAMS FOUNDATION**
The Arts and Culture Commission heard a presentation from Amer Budayr representing the SunJams Foundation and elaborating on the organization's mini-grant funding request totaling \$2,000, in support of the "Annex Sessions".

He shared that the Public Art Fund's estimated ending balance on June 30, 2026, will be approximately \$160,000 with annual expenses totaling about \$22,000 for the current fiscal year.

But when a mumps outbreak throws the community into chaos, the group clashes over vaccination policies, personal freedom, and the limits of tolerance.

Written before the COVID-19 pandemic but made even more relevant by it, *Eureka Day* brilliantly captures how quickly shared values can fracture when fear, misinformation, and ideology collide, **creating a comedy that is as poignant as it is uproariously funny.**
